Resolution on FICSA Training on Classification in Geneva

The Staff Council,

Concerned about the process of departmental reorganization across the organization and its possible ramification on jobs, career development and mobility of staff as a result of the Secretary General reform proposal initiative and GSDM;

Recognizing the importance of strengthening the broad understanding of UN Staff Union Officials on matters pertaining to office reorganization, job classification and vacancy management so as to effectively support and assist UN Staff members who will be affected by these reform initiatives;

Cognizant of the need to make good uses of the training courses opportunities provided by FICSA on job classification so as to enable the Union leadership to further provide the level of assistance and support to all staff;

Decides to authorize the President's participation to the FICSA's Training session from 25 April to 27 April 2018.

Further decides to authorize, with funds from the UN Staff Union Reserves, upon presentation of proper documentation, and based on the enclosed estimated budget, up to a total amount of **US \$ 6,000** related to the travel of the UN Staff Union President to attend the FICSA classification training courses in Geneva.
